## QUALIFICATIONS

1. Entering High School Freshmen and Sophomores
2. Who evince
  - Superior aptitude and interest in languages
  - Strong moral character (letters of reference)
  - Generosity of spirit (written or narrative examples, references)
  - Strong academic performance across domains (grades)
  - Strong academic ability across domains (SSAT)

## APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Complete Sparhawk School General Application Form.
2. Submit two academic letters of recommendation, one of which is to come from the applicant's language teacher if the student has already taken a language course.
3. One non-academic letter of recommendation from an appropriate individual able to speak to the applicant's interest and/or aptitude in pursuing language coursework (optional).
4. Completion of the Sparhawk Language Scholarship Questionnaire (attached).
5. Language Aptitude Test, to be administered by Sparhawk faculty at the time of Interview.
6. Applicant Interview.

## OBLIGATION

Language scholarship recipients will be required to:

1. Pursue continuous study in at least one language through 12th grade.
2. Maintain a minimum academic grade of 3.5 in Language.
3. Maintain a minimum academic grade of 3.0 in all coursework.
4. Maintain a minimum humanistic grade of 3.3 in all coursework.
5. Attend at all Language Department sponsored events.
